

Personal Social and Emotional Development

This term the children will further take part in active learning where they will find out about and explore by making links to what they already know. They will be encouraged to have their own ideas and to persevere to achieve what they have set out to do. They will continue to develop their skills in listening to others and taking on board what they say.

Physical Development

During this term the children will continue to take part in kinetic letter writing everyday which will develop their fine motor skills. They will learn how to play a range of games which involve using different equipment and they will learn to understand the rules of different games.

Literacy

In literacy the children will continue to learn how to segment and blend sounds in words for reading, writing and spelling. They will use books and computers to retrieve information and find out facts. They will also further their understanding of sentence construction and using punctuation, connectives and adjectives. They will also be using using their knowledge of stories to create their own fairy tales

Communication and Language

The children will continue to develop their skills in listening attentively in a range of situations. Through stories they will accurately anticipate key events and respond to what they hear with relevant comments, questions or actions.

Summer Term 1



Understanding the World

Throughout this term the children will be finding out about the monarchy. They will be looking at how castles were made and designed and they will also discuss similarities and differences between the different castles and their settings.

The children will show their understanding of technology by explaining how things work, engaging in a range of different computer programs. Children will recognise that a range of technology is used in places such as homes and schools. They will also select and use technology for particular purposes.

Expressive Arts and Design

During this term the children will further their repertoire of songs and dances and explore the different sounds of instruments. They will experiment to create different textures and understand that different media can be combined to create new effects. They will continue to learn how to introduce narratives into their play and play co-operatively as part of a group

Mathematics

During this term the children will learn about money including the different values of each coin and use the vocabulary involved with money. They will continue to develop their understanding of 1 more and 1 less and use the vocabulary involved with addition and subtraction. They will explore weight and capacity and will continue to identify mathematical problems and how to solve them.
