# This term we will

## Personal, Social & Emotional.

- Learning how to be good friends with each other and with the adults in school and gaining our confidence to start conversations with them.
- Learning how to talk to our teachers about what we already know and ask questions about what we are learning.
- Able to understand that sometimes our routines change when we are in school, as we are experiencing lots of new things.

## Communication.

- Following instructions that are given to us by making sure that we listen carefully.
- Finding out lot of new words that we can use like...
- ...the word 'prepositions' – these are words like 'under; 'on top' and 'behind.'

## Physical.

- Drawing enormous lines and circles with different pencils, chinks and pens and also in the air with our hands and arms.
- Learning to use the woodwork bench and tools safely.
- Practising our exercises that will help us to have good handwriting skills.

## Literacy.

- Continuing to learn new sounds and to link them to letters.
- Using what we know about sounds in our play.
- Starting to recognise the sounds we have learnt in books and in the environment around us.

## Mathematics.

- Comparing and dividing groups of objects and learning that they can still total the same.
- Recognising numbers and numerical patterns in our environment.
- Learning about 3D shapes and what they are called.

## Understanding the World.

- Learning about why we have celebrations and events within our own cultures and of others too.
- Going to look at similarities, differences, patterns and change in our world.
- Starting to use different ICT equipment and toys.

## Expressive Arts & Design.

- Using different ways to make marks and pictures, like dipping old tea bags in paint and splatting them on paper.
- Using and making different items and objects to help us in our role play.
- Learning different instrument's names and 'having a go' at playing them to a rhythm and beat.
